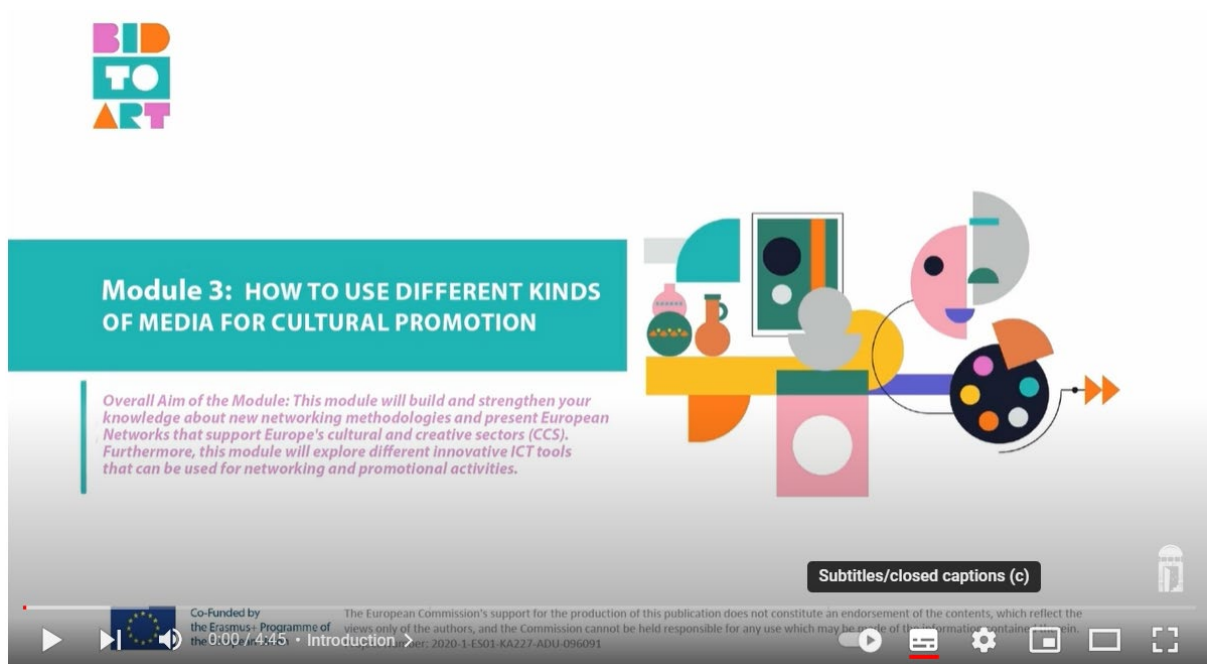
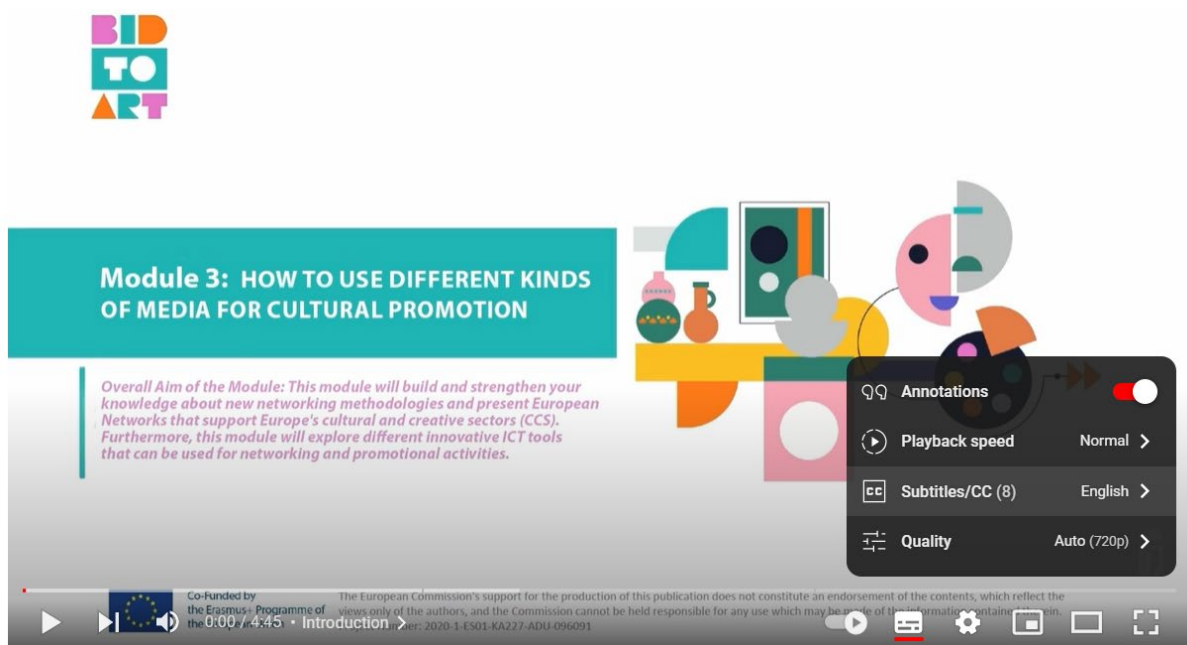


1. How to turn on subtitles



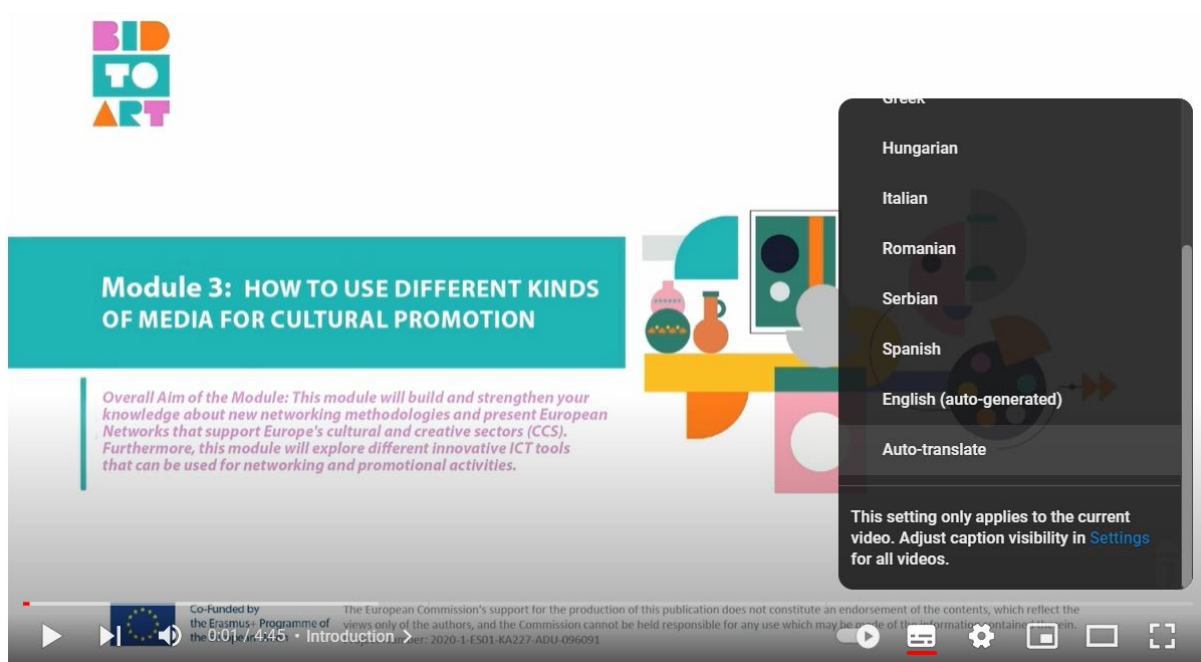
In the down bar, click on the “subtitles/closed captions” icon to activate them. If a video doesn't have uploaded subtitles by the creator, automatic subtitles from YouTube will be generated.

2. How to switch the language



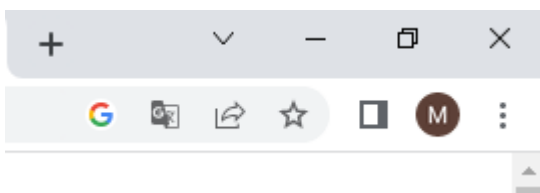
Go to the Configurations of the video, and you'll find the subtitles in every language available. Click on “Subtitles/CC” and choose the language you want.

3. How to open subtitles in different languages with Auto-translation



If you want subtitles in a language that is not available, you can go to the same Configurations, scroll down and you'll find "Auto-translate". Click there, and then choose your preferred language.

4. How to translate a webpage



If you use google chrome and open a page that is not in your default language, you'll find an icon for automatic translation on the top right of your screen. Click it and choose your preferred language.

You can also right-click anywhere on the page and then click "Translate to [Language]".
